

Welcome to Torino!

This city of nearly one million inhabitants was founded by the Romans as a military outpost to become one of the main cities of the Italian state. It then became the first Italian Capital City after the unification of the Nation.

The city is full of historical places, from Roman ruins to the Royal palace. You'll need more than the two days of the conference to visit it!

The conference will be hosted in Politecnico di Torino, a State University founded in 1906 that nowadays counts more than 31'000 students, strong connections with some of the biggest industries in Italy and worldwide, and an incessantly growing performance in all the fields of engineering research.

Transportations:

Taxis to/from the city center and *Torino-Caselle* airport cost about 35 Euros and can be shared. The journey takes 30-45 minutes, depending on traffic.

A frequent bus service (every 30' most of the time) is also available from/to the two main railway Torino stations. The journey takes about 50 minutes and the ticket costs €6.50. All the information can be found here:

There is a single metro line in Torino, and the closest station to the conference venue is VINZAGLIO. Buses and trams complete the public transportation offer. More information can be found at the website <http://www.gtt.to.it/cms/en/>

You can buy tickets for public transportations in any metro station, in any tobacco shop or, if your smartphone has NFC communication, using the app *GTT - TO Move*.

The cost for a 100 minutes ticket (single metro ride, free bus transfers) is 1,70€; a daily ticket is 4,00€ and the "Multi-day" ticket is 7,50€ for 48h or 10,00€ for 72h.

Taxis work 24h a day and can be called and booked dialing (+39) 0115730 or (+39) 0115737. Alternatively you can use the app *Wetaxi* that will allow you to book a licensed taxi from your GPS location to the address of your choice.

Conference venue:

The conference will take place in the MAXWELL conference room of the Department of Electronics and Telecommunications. The building is located in *corso Castelfidardo 36*. Once there, you will see two bridges. Facing the *General Motors Building*, enter the building from the left-hand-side bridge, just under the bridge pillar, following the indication for the DET (Department of Electronic and Telecommunications), take the elevator up to the 5th floor. Our volunteers will be there to assist you. The photograph below will help orienting yourself.



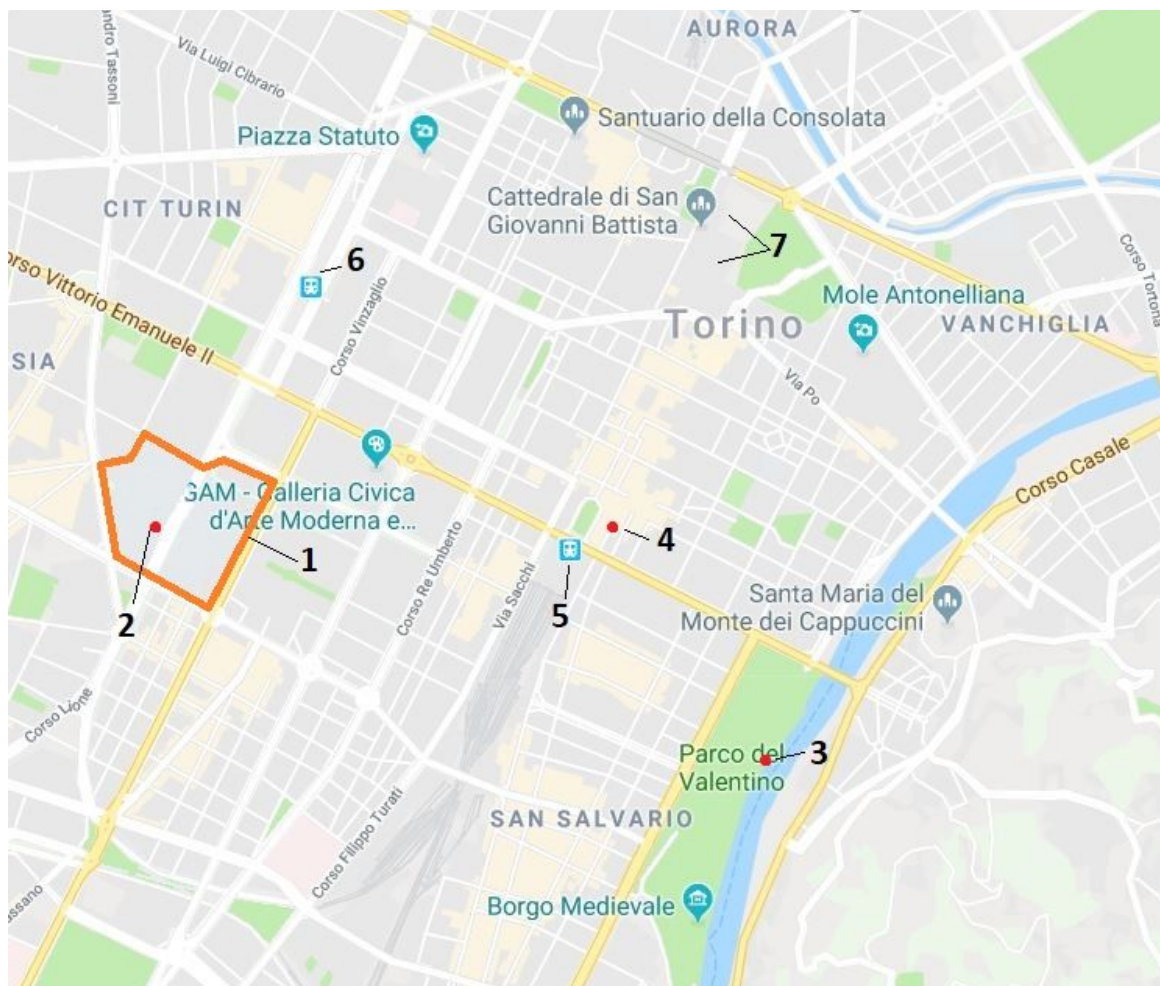
After the conference:
